# **Job Description**

Title: **Water and Sewer Field Maintenance Technician**

Reports to: Director of Public Works

Classification: Non-Exempt

Grade:

## I. Primary Function/General Purpose

To perform highly skilled work in the installation, repair and maintenance of water and sewer lines, wells, pump stations and appurtenances and related work as required. Work is performed under regular supervision of the Water and Sewer Field Supervisor.

## II. Employment qualifications:

- High School Diploma or GED
- Considerable progressive experience in the maintenance, repair and/or construction of water and sewer lines
- Considerable experience with heavy equipment, tools and equipment
- Thorough knowledge in the operation of the tools, materials and equipment used in the installation, replacement, maintenance and repair of utility lines
- Thorough knowledge in the use of common hand and power tools
- Thorough knowledge in the operation of backhoes and other construction equipment
- The ability to establish and maintain effective working relationships with coworkers
- Valid Virginia driver's license and CDL
- Continued education and training as required

## III. Essential job functions:

- Assists the Water and Sewer Field Supervisor in overseeing and performing work in the repair and maintenance of water and sewer lines and appurtenances
- Operates water and sewer construction, maintenance, inspection and heavy equipment with substantial skills
- Responds to emergency and customer calls
- Responds to overflows and backups
- Ensures maintenance and proper operation of equipment
- Ensures safe working conditions
- Works with property owners and contractors
- Cleans and inspects sewer lines, grease traps, pump stations and associated devices and structures
- Assists with crew efficiency, effectiveness, growth and success
- Assists with organizing crew, scheduling of work and maintains records
- Makes water and sewer taps
- Installs water meters, fire hydrants and valves and performs related maintenance

#### IV. Other job functions:

- Performs other related tasks as required
- Requires courtesy, discretion and use of sound judgment when dealing with others

#### V. Physical demands:

- The physical demands described here are representative of those that must be met by an employee to successfully perform the essential functions of this job.
- While performing the duties of this job, the employee will be required to exert 100 pounds of force occasionally, up to 50 pounds of force frequently and up to 20 pounds of force constantly to move objects.
- The employee will be required to climb, balance, stoop, kneel, crouch, reach, stand, walk, push, pull, lift, finger, grasp and use repetitive motions.
- The employee will be required to use vocal communication to express or exchange idea by means of the spoken word. Hearing is required to perceive information at normal spoken word levels. Visual acuity is required for depth perception, color perception, visual inspection involving small defects and/or small parts, use of measuring devices, assembly or fabrication of parts at or within arms' length, operation of machines, operation of motor vehicles or equipment, determining the accuracy and thoroughness of work, and observing general surroundings

#### VI. Work environment:

- The work environment characteristics described here are representative of those an employee encounters while performing the essential functions of this job.
- This position is classified as having an occupational exposure to bloodborne pathogens and as safety sensitive to OSHA compliance.
- While performing the duties of this position, the employee is subject to inside and outside environmental conditions, extreme cold, hazard, atmospheric conditions and oils
- The employee may be exposed to biological/bloodborne pathogens, chemical, electrical or mechanical hazards and will be required to wear specialized personal protective equipment
