Effective March 12, 2020, Governor Ralph S. Northam declared under Executive Order that a State of Emergency exists in the Commonwealth of Virginia due to the potential spread of COVID-19, a communicable disease and public health threat.

In response to this Executive Order, the Colonial Beach Director of Emergency Services has issued a State of Emergency for the Town of Colonial Beach effective March 15, 2020.

Until further notice, town offices are hereby closed to the public, including Finance/Treasurer, Planning and Community Development, Town Clerk, and Parks and Recreation and all scheduled governmental meetings are cancelled.
