

**Resolution #16-20, Amends Penalties and Interest for Late Payments of 2019 Personal Property Taxes, 2019 Machinery and Tools Taxes, and 2020 Real Estate Taxes to Zero (0.00%) Percent from April 1, 2020 to June 30, 2020 and to Extend the Time for Payment of Vehicle License Taxes to June 30, 2020**

**EMERGENCY RESOLUTION – To Amend Penalties and Interest on Late Payments of 2019 Personal Property Taxes, 2019 Machinery and Tools Taxes, and 2020 Real Estate Taxes to Zero Percent (0.00%) From April 1, 2020 to June 30, 2020 and to Extend the Time for Payment of Vehicle License Taxes to June 30, 2020.**

**WHEREAS**, the Town of Colonial Beach Director of Emergency Services declared a local emergency on March 15, 2020 due to the spread of COVID-19; and,

**WHEREAS**, the Colonial Beach Town Council wishes to assist its residents and businesses as the community contends with the disaster and emergency caused by the COVID-19 pandemic; and,

**WHEREAS**, Section 15.2-1413 of the Code of Virginia authorizes the Town Council to act to assure continuity in government in the event of a disaster; and,

**WHEREAS**, the Town Council determines that amending penalties and interest for late payment of tangible personal property taxes, machinery and tools taxes, and real estate taxes and extending the due date for vehicle license tax, will promote continuity of government and grant needed relief to businesses and individuals affected by the disaster.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Town Council that Resolution #16-20 is hereby ratified and confirmed.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Town Council that Resolution #16-20 is hereby effective immediately through June 30, 2020.
