

RESOLUTION #49-21, RATIFYING A DECLARATION OF LOCAL EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, October 29, 2021 the effects of severe weather and loss and interruption of vital Town services posed by recent heavy rains, tidal surge, and wind gust that began on October 28, 2021, were of sufficient severity and magnitude to warrant coordinated local government action to prevent and alleviate potential damage, loss, hardship or suffering; and

WHEREAS, the Director of Emergency Management for the Town of Colonial Beach declared a local emergency on October 29, 2021 at 1:30 PM, pursuant to Virginia Code §44-146.21, as amended and pursuant to the authorization and consent of Town Council.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Colonial Beach Town Council at its Meeting on November 3, 2021, that the effects of severe weather and loss and interruption of vital Town services posed by the heavy rain, tidal surge, and wind gust on the 28th and 29th day of October, 2021 is recognized, and the Declaration of Local Emergency made by the Director of Emergency Management on October 29, 2021 is ratified.

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Colonial Beach Town Council declares that the State of Local Emergency remained in effect until October 30, 2021 at 1:30 PM.

Upon motion made by Mr. Cabrey and seconded by Dr. Self Sullivan, Resolution #49-21, as written, passed with a unanimous vote of council members present.
